- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2017, growing by 3,540. Population is expected to increase by 5.7% between 2022 and 2027, adding 7,861.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 1.1% in Marathon County, WI from 75,637 to 74,808. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 3.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 69.1% to 65.9% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.9% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.9% below the national average), and **14.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.




Sep 2022 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Marathon County, WI had a September 2022 unemployment rate of 2.74%, decreasing from 2.92% 5 years before.



Millennials




Veterans

Marathon County, WI has 7,743 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7,422.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 40,914 people 55 or older, while there are 45,515 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient







Top Occupation Location Quotient




